Camp right inside the Bungles, before experiencing the beauty of Broome and Cable Beach.

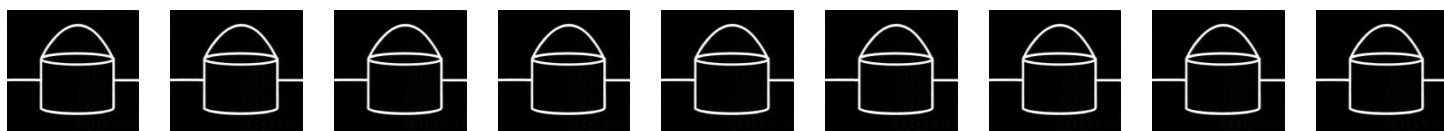

BOOKINGS: Can only be confirmed with the payment of \$200 deposit. Final payment falls due 45 days before departure. Cheques are to be made payable to 'Outback Track Tours Pty Ltd'. We also accept VISA, MASTERCARD and BANKCARD. All credit card transactions over \$250.00 will attract a 3% fee.
TRAVEL INSURANCE: We strongly recommend travel insurance against loss of possessions, accident and cancellation through unforeseen circumstances. Insurance is available at the office. **PLEASE NOTE:** This is a camping tour, however cabin accommodation is available at some of the places where we camp, a refund is not given for unused camping portion if you choose to stay in accommodation. - All camping gear including two-person tents, foam sleep mats, tables and chairs.
- Any additional flights, cruises & side excursions are optional extras.
- Note on the itinerary, "Bush Camps" do not have facilities; "Camps" are at Caravan Parks with full facilities, National Park campsites have limited facilities.

If you wish to allow extra time either side of the tour, we can arrange accommodation at Heavitree Gap Resort with special rates for our passengers. Please let us know on booking if you require this service. An airport shuttle service is available either through the resort or at the airport.

DAY 1 TANAMI TRACK

Today we meet passengers at the Heavitree Gap Resort at 7am for a 7.30am departure. We can do any city pickups as required please advise on booking and you will be advised of your collection time. We start our journey by travelling along the Tanami Track, passing the isolated roadhouse at Rabbit Flat. We spend our first night under the stars with a true bush camp.

BUSH CAMP: TANAMI (LD)

DAY 2 TANAMI TRACK

Our second day on the Tanami, and we will have the opportunity to see the fascinating Wolfe Creek Meteorite Crater. This geological wonder is the second largest of its type in the world.

BUSH CAMP: TANAMI (BLD)

DAY 3 BUNGLE BUNGLES

Today we travel along the Tanami, arriving at the Bungle Bungle National Park. We spend the next two nights at our base camp right inside the Bungles. We will be exploring the area over the next two days.

CAMP: BUNGLE BUNGLE NP (BLD)

DAY 4 BUNGLE BUNGLE NP

Time to explore the Bungles. There will be the opportunity to explore Piccaninny Creek,

Cathedral Gorge and the Beehive. Some may choose to take an optional helicopter flight over this natural wonder.

CAMP: BUNGLE BUNGLE NP (BLD)

DAY 5 FITZROY CROSSING

We travel to Geikie Gorge with the possibility of a Geikie Gorge Cruise (optional extra).

This stunning gorge offers a variety of wildlife, including sawfish, barramundi and freshwater crocodiles. Our overnight stay will be at the distinctive Kimberley town of Fitzroy Crossing.

CAMP: FITZROY CROSSING (BLD)

DAY 6 WINDJANA GORGE

From Fitzroy Crossing, we visit the spectacular Windjana Gorge, and walk through the stunning Tunnel Creek National Park in the Napier Range.

CAMP: WINDJANA GORGE NP (BLD)

DAY 7 BROOME

We travel via Derby before arriving at Broome, the great pearling center with its romantic history.

CAMP: BROOME (BLD)

DAY 8 BROOME

FREE DAY – A free day will allow time to explore and enjoy this exotic town – visit the Bird Observatory, swim in the warm blue waters of the Indian Ocean at Cable Beach, take a scenic flight or simply wander around Chinatown with its Pearl shops and galleries.

CAMP: BROOME (B)

DAY 9 PORT HEDLAND

From Broome we travel along the Great Northern Highway via Sandfire Flat Roadhouse to Port Hedland. Port Hedland handles the largest iron ore export tonnage of any Australian port. Salt production is another major industry.

CAMP: PORT HEDLAND (BLD)

DAY 10 TOM PRICE

Heading away from the coast, we travel into iron ore country of the Pilbara with a night at the mining town Tom Price.

CAMP: TOM PRICE (BLD)

DAY 11 TOM PRICE

The nearby Karijini National Park has breathtaking gorges, crystal clear rock pools and offers stunning scenery in the Hamersley Ranges.

CAMP: TOM PRICE (BLD)

DAY 12 EXMOUTH

Today we travel via Nanutarra Roadhouse to Exmouth on the north-eastern side of the NW cape.

CAMP: EXMOUTH (BLD)

DAY 13 EXMOUTH

Exmouth and the Cape Range National Park beckon, while our exploration includes Ningaloo Marine Park, one of the largest fringing coral reefs in the world.

CAMP: EXMOUTH (BLD)

DAY 14 DENHAM

We travel from Exmouth via Carnarvon, along the coast to Shark Bay for a relaxing stay at seaside Denham, home of the friendly dolphins at Monkey Mia.

CAMP: DENHAM (BLD)

DAY 15 DENHAM

Today we spend the whole day at magnificent Monkey Mia, where we can see dolphins and maybe take an optional Dugong Cruise.

CAMP: DENHAM (BLD)

DAY 16 GERALDTON

Today we depart Denham and make our way to Hamelin Pool, where we can see the ancient Stromatolites and Shell Beach, a 110km stretch of unique Australian coastline comprising of tiny shells.

CAMP: GERALDTON (BLD)

DAY 17 LEINSTER

We travel from Geraldton via Mount Magnet to former gold mining town of Leonora, once the hometown of youthful Herbert Hoover who was the manager of nearby sons of Gwalia mine.

BUSH CAMP: LEONORA (BLD)

DAY 18 TJULAYIRLA

We start our amazing trek across the desert from Leonora via Laverton and on the Great Central Highway, to Tjukayirla where we camp under the stars.

BUSH CAMP: TJUKAYIRLA (BLD)

DAY 19 WARAKURNA

From Tjukayirla we head to Warburton, an excellent aboriginal art area before traveling to Warakurna, opposite the Giles Meteorological Weather Station. Today we cross the border into NT via Docker River.

BUSH CAMP: DOCKER RIVER (BLD)

DAY 20 ULURU/KATA TJUTA

We pass the spectacular Petermann Ranges and also visit historical Lasseters Cave, before arriving at Kata Tjuta and Uluru. This morning we visit the fascinating Uluru-Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre, as well as seeing the world's largest monolith up close. We also have the chance to see the Olgas before traveling on to Alice Springs. Our tour finishes on arrival in Alice Springs. We can arrange drop-offs to hotels for those who require it.

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
